Your Four-Step Starting Path

01

Define the learner journey

Describe who enters the program, what they should understand first, and the outcome of each learning level.

02

Map the seven volumes

Assign volumes and supporting resources to foundation, exploration, and advanced-study stages.

03

Create a repeatable lesson model

Use the same sequence for context, reading, discussion, application, and further study.

04

Train and review

Prepare facilitators, collect learner questions, review outcomes, and revise the curriculum on a regular schedule.

- 2. What must every facilitator understand?
- 3. Which resources are required at each level?
- 4. How will we measure clarity, participation, and progression?
