Your Four-Step Starting Path

01

Orient yourself

Read the canon overview before choosing a volume. Note the place of Enoch, Jubilees, and Meqabyan in the wider tradition.

02

Choose a starting volume

Begin with the part of the collection that best matches your current knowledge and questions.

03

Use a three-part rhythm

Read a short section, record one contextual insight, and write one application or question.

04

Build supporting context

Use the journal, audio library, and study resources to deepen understanding without overwhelming your reading practice.

Discussion and Reflection

- 1. What did this passage reveal about its historical setting?
- 2. What idea differs from my previous understanding?
- 3. What question should I investigate next?
- 4. What practice or perspective can I carry into today?

- Week 1: Canon overview and reading goals
- Week 2: Begin the selected volume
- Week 3: Add one supporting article
- Week 4: Review notes and set the next reading milestone
